
## **Town of Clarence Bike Trails**

The Town of Clarence strives to develop an integrated bike system that meets the needs of the community. Currently there are 2 trails totaling 10.2 miles that run through the Town and connect local parks and historic destinations.



# The Peanut Line Trail begins at the western boundary of Clarence near Transit Road and continues east eventually connecting with the Clarence-Akron-Newstead Trail in the Town of Newstead (an extension of the West Shore Trail). 
